

4. Learning Environment and Support

- 4.1) Please comment on the learning environment that impacted your experience in this module (for example: lecture theatre equipment, the Hub, rooms and facilities, support staff, etc.)
- Error occurred once when doing quiz on the Hub
- Excellent lecturer and classroom vibe. Sometimes the font could be bigger (for equations).
- Good
- Good lecture hall and support staff making sure that the recording was working.
- Great place to have lectures, can see the materials clearly and hear the lecturer clearly.
- I think the the environment was excellent.
- I understand that it's a privilege and not a right to have access to lecture recordings, however, it was very difficult on the recordings to view the lecturer's notes on the whiteboard. The video camera sometimes didn't zoom in enough or the recording was not focused. Otherwise it was good.
- Lecture setup and use of slides and whiteboard was very effective in communicating lecture content.
- Lecture theatre was appropriate. Recordings, particularly of what was written on the board were very useful for rewatching and analyzing at own pace.
- Lecture theatre was great. Spacious enough for everyone. Support staff were helpful for the initial lecture
- Perfect atmosphere for learning, diligent and well written lecture slides and outlets for charging were also useful. However, the front lights (by the lecturer's desk) need to be dimmed down as folks with astigmatism may need to squint to read due to glare.

- 5.2) What would you most like to improve in this module?
- Equation symbols labelled on slides
- Have some optional tutorial sheets to do weekly, probably? Although the exercises in class are pretty good already. Have more exam-style questions incolved.
- I did not like the 4 quizzes as myself and a lot of others missed a few due to a small submission window, However I mentioned this to the lecturer and they were very receptive and offered to change it.
- II would love to see more information on the lecture slides to read up and understand the material, especially for the graphs as I find it hard to follow in lectures when Savitar would speed up in the sessions and I would not have enough time to take notes
- Improved recording of lecture scribbles mainly to lecture note exercises. Additionally, I think it would be nice if the website which we used for the coursework's trading game provided information about which cards were revealed each round (not just the cards which players revealed).
- I really like it, can't think of any
- I would like proper course notes as it helps me learn better.
- More accessible information about exams and coursework. Quiz results take a long time to release
- More practice or questions posed as independent study work to help retain/deepen knowledge. I feel somewhat unprepared for the exam as a result of not doing many questions.
- More practice questions would be nice.

- Not having a participation mark contributing to the final grade
- Perhaps an open discussion format for a short period of one of the lectures, if there were no time constraints of course. Also the software for quiz submission needs upgrading, continuous errors when submitting.
- Possibly change the quiz deadline to 48 hours every time as some students had problems
- Slide information density
- Technical difficulties on the quizzes, longer window to do the quiz
- The grading of participation is not appropriate. While the course is considered for beginners, by their own confession and by quick analysis, several students have prior experience and knowledge. Their questions often being lessons ahead of current pace and discouraging participation by students who are just being introduced to the topic.
- The interaction in this module is great, but often I can't get the question other students are asking. It would be helpful if the lecturer can repeat the question from students if they find the question valuable.
- The module lead mentioned at the start of the course that he had not intended for an in-person class to be graded on participation but that is was unable to be changed. However how participation is graded is not very effective. Due to the shape, layout of the lecture room and the position of the person keeping track of this, most nametags cannot be seen. Making me think that despite actual participation this may not be recorded and thus not reflected in the grade.
